## ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

(FAMILY MEDICINE)

This pathway is open to a physician with recognized training and certification outside Canada. If you received your family medicine education in Australia, Ireland, the United Kingdom or the United States, you can apply to become a member of the CFPC. Provincial regulators will use this to issue you a license to practice. You will need to have completed sufficient postgraduate training in family medicine/general practice.



## Within three years you must:

- a. Pass the Medical Council of Canada Qualifying Examination Part 1 (MCCQE1)
- b. Receive your Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC)



You can then apply for full licensure from your chosen provincial regulatory authority
